#### **Class Placement Policy**

Today you will have received our Class Placement Policy. This policy outlines the procedures the school has in place when forming classes. We hope to go into our 2020 classes at the end of the year, as we did last year. This will however, be dependent on numbers. Please ensure you read over the policy carefully and send any information regarding your child/ren to the school by Friday 15 November. Any late submissions will not be considered

#### **Kindergarten Orientation**

#### **School Crossing Guard and Kiss and Drop**

It is with great pleasure that I can announce we have a new crossing guard at Shell Cove Public School. Ron will supervise the crossing on Stradbroke Avenue from 8:30 am - 9:00 am and 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm. Please say hi and make him feel welcome. Thank you to the majority of parents, carers and students who are using our Kiss and Drop Zone correctly. Our Kiss and Drop Zone has been designed for your convenience and for your child's safety. Designed for quick entry and exit, this zone minimises congestion and risk when used properly by all parents and carers. To ensure the safety of our students, please ensure you continue to follow the procedures that have been put in place.

- Drivers should not leave their vehicle at any time: To assist with traffic flow, drivers should remain with the car whilst children get in and out. Children should travel with their bags in the car (not in the boot).
- Be timely: If your child is not ready for collection you must leave the Kiss & Drop Zone and re-enter.
- Stay in sequence: Don't cut into the queue. Drop off or pick up your child close to the top of the zone, allowing vehicles following you to enter the zone in an orderly manner.
- Child Safety: Please ensure children get in and out of the vehicle on the kerb side. At no times should students be entering or existing the car via the road side.
- No U-Turns: Do not do U-Turns in busy and congested school zones. It is extremely dangerous and places young children at serious risk.

If you would like to volunteer at Kiss and Drop during the morning, please contact the school.

#### <u>Before and After School Care – Peak Learning and Sports</u>

As of Monday 21 October 2019, Peak Learning and Sports will be opening at 6:30 am instead of 7:00 am. The new operating hours will not affect the current fee schedule that is in place. If you have any further questions, please speak with one of the friendly team at Peak Learning and Sports.

#### Class Splits

When teachers are absent on a day to day basis, all efforts are made to replace them with a casual teacher. However, at times casual teachers are unavailable, particularly at this time of the year and classes do need to be split. When a split occurs, students are generally placed in another class within their grade. For example a Year 2 student will be sent to a Year 1 or a Year 2 class. This ensures that students are still able to access learning activities that are consistent with what is happening within their own classroom. There are times when teachers are out of school supervising a range of extra-curricular activities including sporting teams, creative arts events etc. When this occurs, students have a regular class that they join which ensures they are being taught the same content as other students across the stage.

#### **Market Day**

What a wonderful Market Day we had this year! Congratulations to Stage 3 students and teachers who organised such a successful event. Thank you to the parent volunteers who came and helped on the day and the community members who donated their time and resources. We appreciate the support you give our school. This year, we raised \$10,154. This money will be used to purchase equipment for our playground.

#### **Swimming Carnival**

This year's swimming carnival will be held at Oak Flats Pool on Monday 2 December. Please refer to the information that will be sent out on Thursday, 31 October 2019. Please note that all students attending the carnival must travel to and from the event via bus.

#### **Swimming and Water Safety Program**

Shell Cove Public School will be running a 10 day School Swimming and Water Safety Program from Monday 21 October – Friday 1 November. Students who have registered for this program in Years 2, 3 and 4 will travel by bus to and from Kiama Leisure Centre. The program runs from 12:20 pm – 2:55 pm each day and Mrs Pather and Mrs Kirwan will be attending. It is recommended that students wear their swimmers underneath their school clothes. Please ensure that all items (towel, swimmers, goggles etc.) are clearly labelled with student's full name and class. Students in 2K and 3P who are not involved in the School Swimming and Water Safety Program will be split into another class where they will continue to be involved in regular school lessons.

#### <u>Playground</u>

The construction phase of our new playground has started and we are excited to have this project up and running. On Tuesday 22 October, a play-based educator from Reverse Garbage in Marrickville will attend our school and will host a session with our teachers and our playground committee on how to effectively use and implement loose parts play pods within our playground. Loose parts play supports invention, divergent thinking, problem solving, team work and activates children's imagination. Loose parts are open-ended items that can be moved, carried, combined, redesigned, lined up, and taken apart and put back together in countless ways. More information can be found at:

- All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test to be held on Thursday

#### School Travel – Term 4 2019

#### 2020 School Travel Applications Now Open

Applications for student travel in 2020 opened on Friday, 11 October 2019.

Students progressing to Year 3 and Year 7 no longer need to re-apply if they:

- are continuing at the same school
- are residing at the same address
- have not been sent an expiry notification from Transport for NSW.

Where a student meets the new distance eligibility, the system will automatically update their entitlement. If they do not meet the new eligibility, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If students need to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to

https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails

Applications need to be submitted before 31 December 2019 to ensure student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card is not cancelled. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2019, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2020.
