
The importance of communication has always been an area that our school has looked to improve. We currently use a school website, school Facebook page, the Sentral Parent Portal and newsletter to communicate information.

Intention to apply for Year 7 placement in a selective high school in 2022

Dear Parent/Carer,

Selective high schools cater for academically gifted students with high potential who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic standard. Selective high schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, and by using specialised teaching methods.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 11 March 2021.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2022, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available in late September 2020 at https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.

The application website opens at that link on 13 October 2020 and closes on 16 November 2020. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after 13 October 2020.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

The tear-off slip below is not an application and the school cannot apply on your behalf.

ONLINE ENROLMENT

We are excited to announce that the new Online Enrolment System is now available on our website.

The Online Enrolment System is designed to provide flexibility for our parents to submit an enrolment application online and at the time that best suits you. The application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:

- . Enrolments into **local** schools only;
- . Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents; and
- . Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enrol online. If, however, you do not feel comfortable completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from the front office or can be downloaded from the Departments 'going to a public school' site.

Technical phone support is available for parents completing an online enrolment through the online enrolment system, together with the current online support form. Parents can call 1300 679 338 between 7:30am and 6:00pm, Monday to Friday.

Covid-19 has surely turned things upside down in all aspects of life. In particular our Sacramental Programs, the First Reconciliation, Holy Communion, and the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Programs are designed to be a Parish and Parents Partnership with School Support. Unfortunately we have to prepare our children for the Sacrament differently this year. All of our sessions will be held at Nazareth and Stella Maris Parish School at the commence of Term 4. We will need parents to work with their children, completing Home Activities each week, the children will do their class activities during the sessions at School. For the State School Children, classes will be held on Sunday afternoon at 3pm First Reconciliation will be celebrated during the School hours.

First Holy Communion (subject to Covid restrictions) will be celebrated 3:00PM Saturday28 November 2020 11:00AM Sunday 29 November 2020 Confirmation (subject to Covid restrictions) will be celebrated 6:00PM Thursday 5 November 2020 6:00PM Friday 6 November 2020 First Reconciliation & Holy Communion

The sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion are combined as the Parish's Partners Program. Attendance at this program is compulsory for both children and their parents, and children must be in year 3 at school or older to complete the program. For children attending State School please register your child by contact the Parish Office during office hours. Confirmation The sacrament of Confirmation is open to children who have completed their other sacraments, and are in year 6 at school or older. For children attending State School please register your child by contact the Parish Office during office hours.





BYOD DEVICES 2021

Are you looking to purchase a new device for your child? Upgrading? Early Christmas shopping? Preparing for Year 3 2021?

Shipping is charged at a flat rate and delivery should be within a few days depending on supply.

Stage 2 (Year 3/4) and Stage 3 (Year 5/6) students are required to bring a device to school each day.

If you need to purchase a new device for your child, we suggest either: Apple Ipad (including protective case and keyboard), Chrome Book or Laptop. All devices listed in the portal meet the school network requirements.

Please note you do not need to purchase a NEW device, this is optional. Students can bring in an older device, if it meets the requirements outlined in the note. The school does have a small number of shared devices, which are shared between 5-6 classes at a time so they are not always available for lessons.























