UPDATE OF YEAR 5 OPPORTUNITY CLASS PLACEMENT PROCESS FOR 2021

I would like to update you on the modified timeline for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2021.

The Opportunity Class Placement Test was conducted on Wednesday 18 November 2020 in 1068 primary schools and test centres across NSW. We expect the results will be released to parents and schools in mid-January 2021.

Parents who are offered placement on behalf of their children will have just <u>one week to respond</u> to their offers.

Parents are being emailed to ensure that they watch their emails or depute someone else to respond on their behalf if they will be out of contact when the results are released as offers will lapse if parents do not respond in time.

Mid-January 2021 – Placement outcome information is sent to parents and schools. Parents with offers must respond within one week.

From mid-January 2021 - Parents accept or decline offers. The Reserve List is activated.


